He served as High School Choral Director and Music Department Chairman for the Pequea Valley School District and was Adjunct Professor at Millersville University. Mark has a BS degree in Music Education from Millersville University and Master of Music in Conducting from Penn State.

Jonathan Shoff earned his bachelor's degree in music education from Millersville University with a concentration in piano and a minor in voice. He also holds a Master of Music from West Chester University. Jonathan teaches elementary school music in the School District of Lancaster. He teaches private instrumental and voice lessons, accompanies the Mennonite Children's Choir of Lancaster, and serves as artistic director for the Music for Everyone Lancaster Community Chorus.

Ashley D'Onofrio has been teaching music to 7th and 8th grade students since 2007 at Fred S. Engle middle school in the Avon Grove School District. She directs the Middle School Choir, Avon Grove Singers, and Women's Choir where they have performed at festivals and throughout the Avon Grove community. She has also been the director of the middle school musical with shows such as "Cinderella," "Oklahoma," and "The Little Mermaid." Ashley has a BSE in Music from Millersville University and currently holds a masters equivalency in education. Her past experience in church music has been performing Solos and singing in the choir at Grandview United Methodist Church.

Katie Sina Kindig holds a BFA in Music Theater from Shenandoah Conservatory and University. She has performed professionally in New York City, national tours, in regional theatre and locally at the Fulton Theatre. Some of her favorite roles performed there include Mary Poppins in *Mary Poppins*, Glinda in *The Wizard of Oz*, Truly Scrumptious in *Chitty Chitty Bang Bang!*, along with many Zany Characters in the Family series shows. She teaches camps and classes through the Fulton's Education Department, choreographs the shows at Lancaster Mennonite High School, and teaches yoga at the YWCA. She most recently began role of Director of Children's Ministry here at FPC and she's very grateful to be a part of the FPC kid's choral camp for her second year!

Stephan L. Englehart is a 2014 graduate of Lebanon Valley College and holds degrees in both Music Education and Music with a vocal concentration. He served as the interim band director at Warwick Middle and High Schools from September until November 2016. He currently works at Kitchen Kettle Village where he makes candy and helps to train new employees, the Substitute Teacher Service where he serves as a day to day substitute, serves as Tenor Section Leader at First Presbyterian Church of Lancaster, and teaches private voice lessons at the Lancaster Conservatory of Music.
